

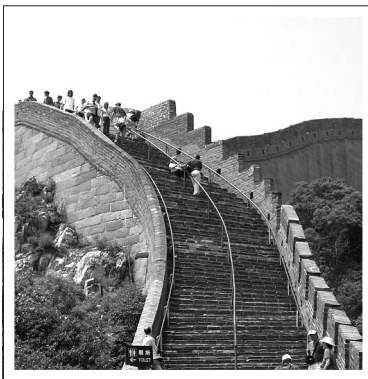
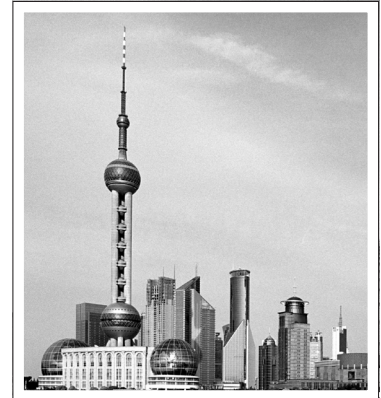
SUMMER 2007 STUDY ABROAD INFORMATION MEETING FOR
