Students will participate in a brief, informal interview with 2 Study Abroad faculty. Deposits will be held by the vendor until it is determined that a minimum of 20 participants have enrolled. Your full deposit will be returned in the event that the China Study Abroad program is cancelled due to low enrollment.
